# BUILDING EN ERGY PERFORMANCE PROGRAM

#### WHAT IS BEPP?

The Building Energy Performance Program (BEPP), established through the Building Energy Performance Policy, is designed to improve energy and water efficiency in Philadelphia's largest non-residential buildings. Often referred to as "building tune-ups," BEPP helps building owners reduce energy consumption and operating costs while enhancing overall performance.

## ELIGIBILITY & COMPLIANCE PROCESS

- → September 30, 2024 (PAST DUE)
  - ◆ Tune-up report deadline for 50,000–70,000 sq. ft. buildings.
  - Tune-up specialists submitting 2024 reports must be certified by this date.
- → January 3, 2026
  - Updated alternative compliance plans for large portfolios are due.
- → April 4, 2026
  - ◆ Deadline for certifying high performance, requesting an alternative exemption, and making extension requests for buildings over 200,000 sq. ft.
- → September 30, 2026
  - Tune-up report deadline for buildings over 200,000 sq. ft.
  - Tune-up specialists submitting 2026 reports must be certified by this date.
